The Committee on Health, under the leadership of Dr. Louis Sullivan, then Secretary of Health and Human Services, recommended that safe water throughout Africa be established as a long term goal of the Summit.

Some facts:

- ❖ 30,000 children die each day from contaminated water
- ❖ 85% of all diseases in African children under 5-years of age are caused by water-borne illnesses
- ❖ The United Nations reports that 20% of the worlds' population struggles to gain access to safe drinking water each day
- ❖ Technology exist to eradicate such suffering, but past efforts have failed to achieve sustainable results

Our Funds will:

- Provide Sale, sustainable water to rural villages in Africa
- Partner with villages to train as needed in equipment, public health and economic development
- Build an entrepreneurial bridge to improve commercial relations between the U.S. and Africa
