- Tournament / Date:** The 9th ISF Senior World Cup - June 11th – 13th, 2010 (Friday, Saturday and Sunday)
- Location:** James I. Moyer Sports Complex (Headquarters)
Botetourt Sports Complex
Arnold Burton Softball Fields, Huff Lane Fields
- Teams:** It is estimated that 80 to 100 teams from throughout the United States will be attending to compete for the World Cup in their division.
- Entry Fee:** \$495.00 Men's Senior Classification will begin on Friday
\$350.00 Women's and Master's Divisions will begin on Saturday

- Ticket Prices:** Admission to all venues is FREE.
- Parking:** No charge for parking – Adequate parking available at the parks.
- Managers Meeting:** Coaches Meeting will be held on Thursday night, June 10th,
@ 7:00PM at the Salem Senior Center – 110 Union Street, Salem, Virginia
(Two members of each team are invited. Refreshments and snacks will be available)
- Team Check-in:** Thursday June 10th – 1:00PM until 5:00PM (James I. Moyer Sports Complex)
Friday June 11th – During preliminary play at each Complex.
Teams must check-in together and you will need a Photo ID's (Drivers License)
are needed for the team check-in.
- Tournament Seeding:** The tournament staff will place the teams in brackets and prepare the preliminary schedule which will be posted on the website approximately three days prior to the tournament. The preliminary game record will be used to seed your team into the double elimination finals. The exact format will depend on the number of teams in each division.
- First Pitch/Opening:** Friday June 11th, 2009 at 8:00AM on Field #1 at the James I. Moyer Sports Complex. We ask that all teams be at the complex by 7:30AM if you are going to be a part of the Opening Ceremonies.
- First Game:** Friday June 11th, the games will begin at 9:00AM at all venue's.
Saturday June 12th and Sunday June 13th, the games will begin at 8:00AM at all venue's. Most divisions will end on Sunday afternoon and the Awards Ceremony will immediately follow the final game. (Some smaller divisions Could conclude on Saturday)
- Divisions of Play:** Teams will be placed in the skill level divisions based on their ISSA Rating and verified by the tournament staff. Divisions are planned for AA, AAA, Majors and Majors Plus in each age classification for men. Divisions could be combined for preliminary play but ALL teams will be given the opportunity to play for their rated division championship against similar rated teams. Competition will be included for Senior Women's teams beginning at 40 and over and Men's Master's beginning at 35 and over. Women and Masters will begin play on Saturday, June 12, 2010
