1. Amendment to Zoning Ordinance

Hold public hearing and consider ordinance on first reading rezoning the property located at 730 Apperson Drive (Tax Map # 247 - 3 - 3) from RSF Residential Single Family District to RB Residential Business District. (Recommend approval, see Page 1 Planning Commission minutes.)

2. Amendment to Zoning Ordinance
