VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE ~ TUESDAY, MAY 30, 2023

DEMOCRATIC PARTY PRIMARY ELECTION ~ TUESDAY, JUNE 20, 2023

THE CONSTITUTION OF VIRGINIA REQUIRES you to be registered in the precinct in which you live to be qualified to vote. To be eligible to vote in the **Democratic Party Primary Election**, on **Tuesday, June 20, 2023**, you must register by **5:00 PM** in the Registrar's Office or online at vote.virginia.gov by **11:59 PM** on **Tuesday, May 30, 2023**.

The Voter Registration Office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM for early, in-person voting beginning on Friday, May 5, and will be open Saturday, June 10 and June 17, 2023 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM for early, in-person voting. The deadline for qualified applicants to vote early, in-person is Saturday, June 17, 2023 by 5:00 PM.

The deadline to apply for an Absentee Ballot by mail is 5:00 PM on Friday, June 9, 2023. The Department of Elections advises applying as early as possible to account for any potential delays in mail delivery.

A Ballot Drop Box is located at the front door of the Registrar's office at 19 E Clay Street for the security and convenience of returning your mail in ballot after office hours. A Ballot Drop Box will also be available on Election Day, June 20, in the Community Room lobby at the Salem Civic Center.

VOTERS WHO VOTE ON ELECTION DAY, JUNE 20, MAY VOTE IN THEIR PRECINCT AT THE SALEM CIVIC CENTER BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6 AM TO 7 PM.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW A VALID PROOF OF IDENTITY AT THE POLLS

You are encouraged to make application for voter registration. Please call the number listed below if you have any questions. All requests for reasonable accommodations due to a disability should be made to the Registrar with at least a 48-hour notice.
