SALEM POLICE MAKE ARREST IN 7-ELEVEN ROBBERY

Salem Police have made an arrest in connection to the 7-Eleven robbery that occurred early Wednesday. Late this morning, 24-year-old Tymon Marquis Smith of Roanoke was arrested without incident and charged with Robbery, Petit Larceny and Wearing a Mask to Conceal Identity.

On August 12, at approximately 4:12 a.m., officers from the Salem Police Department responded to the 7-Eleven convenience store located in the 1700 block of E. Main St. in reference to a reported Armed Robbery.

Upon their arrival, they were advised by the store clerk that a masked male had entered the store and demanded money. The man, who according to the clerk did not display a weapon, left the scene on foot with an undisclosed amount of currency.

Smith is currently being held in the Roanoke County/Salem jail without bond.
