SALEM POLICE MAKE ARRESTS RELATED TO RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES

On February 13, the Salem Police Department made an arrest in connection with multiple residential burglaries that occurred in the 1500 and 1600 blocks of Cliffview Dr. At approximately 11:00 a.m. on the 13th, the Salem PD received a report of a residential burglary in the 1500 block of Cliffview Dr. After receiving a description of the subject, the responding officers were able to locate him along with the suspected stolen property.

Further investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect, 29-year-old Andrew Boothe of Salem. He was taken into custody at approximately 11:30 a.m. and charged with the following offenses:

On February 15, Salem Police make an arrest in connection with two commercial burglaries and a vehicle theft. On the weekend of January 28-29, the police department was called to investigate these three property crimes.
