SALEM POLICE RELEASE DETAILS OF NW HARDWARE BURGLARY

The Salem Police Department is currently investigating a burglary and grand larceny that occurred at Northwest Hardware Store located in the 2900 block of West Main Street.

At approximately 6:50 a.m. on Sunday, March 11, a white male suspect between the ages of 50 and 60 years old, shattering the front door glass of the business with the Chevrolet pickup truck he was driving. The suspect then entered the business, grabbed various power tools from the establishment and eventually fled the scene in the same truck.

The vehicle is described as a mid-1980s, full-size Chevy pickup.
