SALEM POLICE RESPOND TO PARKING LOT INCIDENT

This morning at approximately 7:38 a.m., the Salem Police Department, along with Salem Fire and EMS crews, responded to 1841 West Main St. in reference to a reported accident with injuries.

Upon arrival, officers discovered that two pedestrians, a 35-year-old female and her four-year-old daughter, had been struck by a car in the Walmart parking lot. Both were transported to Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital with minor, non-life threatening injuries.

The driver of the 1998 Ford Taurus has been charged with reckless driving. The incident is still under investigation.
